One Good Turn **By Chris Ryan** Recommended by **Patrick Charnley**

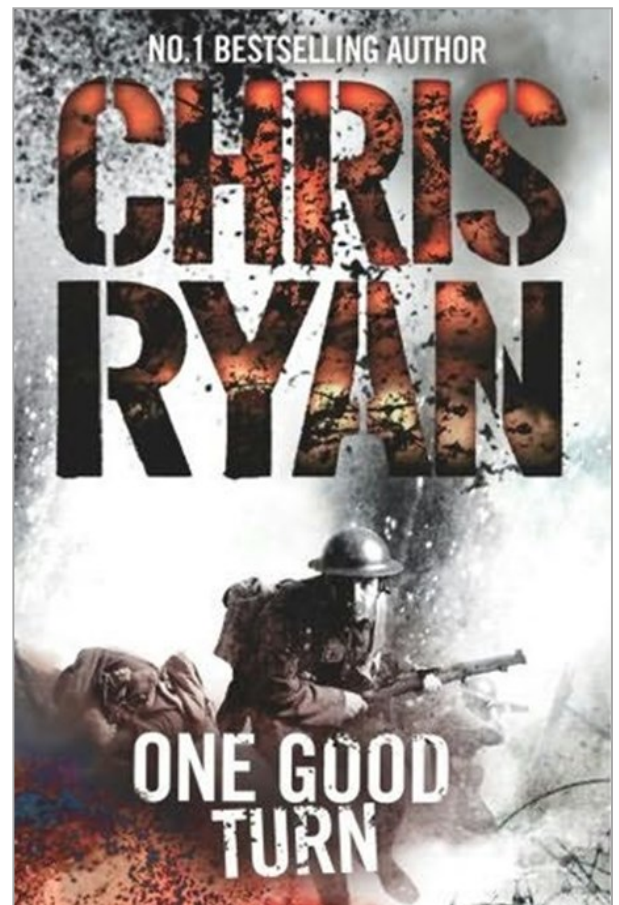
Week Commencing 5 June
