Dear Parent/Carer

English Set Text Study Guides

As you are, by now, aware, your son/daughter is studying three set texts for GCSE English Literature: a post-1914 play or prose text; a Shakespeare play and a 19th century prose text. The final examinations are 'closed book', meaning that pupils need to know the texts well enough to write extensive essays on characters, themes and key events from memory. Thorough and ongoing revision is, therefore, essential.

In order to support your son/daughter as they revise for these exams, we would like to offer a further opportunity to purchase study guides on each of the set texts. Through school, we are able to offer guides on all three texts for a reduced price of £8.25. The full cost, if purchased independently, would be £17.85. We believe that these guides are extremely useful as they are designed with the examination in mind, are user-friendly and focus on the most important characters, themes and events.
