Dear Parents and Carers of Year 12 and Year 13 students,

I am writing to inform you of a change we are making to our morning registration procedures. We have reviewed our Risk Assessment policy in the light of the current national situation and have decided to put a further measure in place to reduce the time sixth form students spend together in the morning.

From Monday 21st September, students in Year 12 and Year 13 will be required to come in to school for their first timetabled session including subject lessons, tutorials, designated study periods and enrichment activities. Students will be registered during that first session and therefore not be required to register in school at 8.45am. Students travelling to school on the school bus should arrive as normal and go into their year group bubble.
