Dear Parents and Carers,

As we come to the end of a very different half term today, I would like to thank you for your support. In amongst shifting local and national guidance, it has been a good to have a sense of (near) normality and routine back in school and to see our young people engaging in their learning.

COVID-19

As you know, we have had a number of positive tests for COVID-19 during the last week. The safety of our children and staff is my priority. I will always act in response to a positive case and I will keep you informed. We are taking regular advice from the DFE, from NHS 119, from Public Health England and the Lancashire Health Protection Team. They advise that we are doing exactly the right thing by following the guidance we are given.

To support us in keeping safe, could I remind all parents of the following:

- Please ensure your child stays at home if they are experiencing any of the coronavirus symptoms. The main one which is presenting at the moment is loss of taste and smell so please be alert for that.
- If someone in your household has symptoms, the whole household needs to selfisolate until the result is back.
- If your child is sent home from school to self-isolate, they must complete the full isolation period, even if they receive a negative test result during that period.
- When travelling to school, pupils should not be travelling in a car with someone from outside their household.
- Please ensure you follow the Tier 3 guidance and restrictions around socialising outside of school. This will help us contain the spread of the virus in school as well.
