At Ripley we offer pupils in Year 11 the chance to gain our Ripley+ award in recognition of the service they have shown to the school and the leadership skills they have developed throughout their time in Key Stage 4. Despite the difficulties posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, we are keen to maintain this important tradition. This award has its roots in the history and faith of our school when our Founders used to award gold medals to pupils who showed the qualities which 'make the finest man and woman'. Today it is an important part of developing our young people and helping them to flourish.

Our pupils take part in a wide range of activities from sport and music to the Duke of Edinburgh's award and charity work; the Ripley+ award recognises those who have demonstrated commitment to developing themselves beyond the requirements of timetabled lessons.
