#### **Lateral Flow Tests**

Please continue to remind your child to take their test twice weekly. It is important you report to us immediately if the test is positive. Please use the <a href="mailto:positivetest@ripley.lancs.sch.uk">positivetest@ripley.lancs.sch.uk</a> email address.

All members of the household must then isolate until a confirmatory PCR test has been taken.

## **Symptoms of COVID**

Whilst infection rates are much lower than they were, we still need to remain vigilant. If your child or someone in the household has symptoms, please keep your child off school until a PCR test has been taken. This includes pupils in Y11 or Y13. We will make sure any assessments will be completed at an alternative time.
