#### **COVID** cases

As you will be aware, we have had a number of cases in Y8 this week after having had very few since our return from lockdown. We currently have 4 cases confirmed via a PCR test and 1 positive lateral flow test which we were notified of today. This has obviously had an impact on a large number of pupils in Year 8 who have had to self-isolate as they have been identified as a close contact. There are also some pupils in other year groups needing to isolate due to being a contact on the school buses.

Thank you to parents for your understanding when we have had to contact you to collect your children or to ask you not to send them in. We desperately do not want to have to send pupils home and are keen for them to come back as soon as possible, however we need to follow the guidance that has been given.

If your child is a close contact of someone who has tested positive, the current advice from Lancashire is that they take a PCR test, even if they have no symptoms. They still need to self-isolate if it is negative, but this helps us track any further close contacts and helps reduce transmission. You can book a PCR test via the NHS website.
