Revision for Easter Mock Examinations

Your mock examinations are just under a month away. You should have already started to prepare for these examinations with some serious revision. It is well known that thorough revision at this stage is good preparation for the summer examinations. When you make revision notes **do not throw them away** – they can be expanded upon and used for further revision.

When you come to revise you should ensure the following:

Routine

- Find a suitable quiet area in which to study, away from distraction.
- Put mobile phones away in a different room.
- Be realistic in what you hope to achieve. You should study in short (25 minute) spells and then have a break for a couple of minutes. For the next session study a different subject.
- Use one short session each night to recap previous work.
- About one and half hours per weekday night (minimum) is appropriate for most people.

Revision

You have received lots of guidance on how to revise and where to find revision resources (see your Year 11 Revision Guide and Firefly).

Your parents have received a guide to the extra support available to you at lunchtime and afterschool (available at ripley.fireflycloud.net/year-11/subject-support). Don't forget to make use of the homework club in the Bridge as a quiet space in which to revise - it is available to you every lunchtime and after school until 4.15pm on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.
