## **Proposed Visit to Stratford July 2022**

We are proposing to run a trip to Stratford for Year 9 pupils to watch a performance of Richard III.

We will depart from school on Thursday 14 July at 08:30 and travel to Stratford by coach. We will arrive back at school on Friday 15 July at approximately 21:00.

The cost of the trip will be £200 per pupil which includes a ticket for the play, a bespoke Shakespeare workshop, guided tour of Stratford, a visit to Shakespeare birthplace trust, accommodation and breakfast, a meal at Pizza Express and coach travel.

There are only 60 places available on this trip and we anticipate that it will be very popular. Places will therefore be allocated on a first come first served basis.

If you wish your son/daughter to take part in this visit, please complete the attached application form and **make your deposit payment of £100 by Thursday 28 April to secure your child's place.** The second instalment of £100 should be paid by Thursday 26 May. If you have any problems using the online payment system please contact the school office for assistance. The application form should be returned to the blue box outside Learning Support.

With regard to cancellations we will endeavour to re-allocate the place but we cannot guarantee a full refund where irrecoverable costs have been incurred.
