
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Set Texts

Set Text 1: A Caucasian Chalk Circle, Bertolt Brecht



Set Design Task for Set Text 1: Design a set for one section/scene of the play. Annotate the design and be ready to explain and justify your choices. Consider the social, historical and political context of the play.

Set Text 2: Yerma, Frederico Garcia Lorca

Research Task for Set Text 2: Carry out some research in to the controversial playwright, Frederico Garcia Lorca. Write a 500 word biography for Lorca.

Devising Task

As part of the course, you will be devising your own original piece of Theatre. You will need to source 3 stimuli that could be used as a starting point for the devised piece. These should be thought provoking stimuli from the following categories;

- Photographs
- > Literature
- > Art
- Poem
- Newspaper Article
- Song Lyrics
- > A piece of music

Practical Task
