INFORMATION FOR STARTING AT RIPLEY

CASHLESS CATERING SYSTEM

If your child intends to use the school catering facilities you will need to ensure they have funds in their account. Payment can be made in cash or online, although the latter will not be available until after pupils have arrived and codes for online payment have been issued. Please note, in line with many companies, we do not accept cheques.

FIRST DAY LUNCH

All Year 7 pupils will be registered for the cashless system on their first day in September, but as we need time to process the funds we have made arrangements for pupils to pay cash on the first day if they wish to have a school lunch. A set lunch will be available for pupils, on this day, at a cost of £2.75. Pupils on free school meals will be exempt from this charge. A packed lunch is also able to be brought into school. Cans/bottles of pop are not allowed in school at any time.

EQUIPMENT

Pupils at Ripley St Thomas are expected to arrive at lessons ready to learn. Excellent behaviour for learning means:

- you arrive to lessons on time
- you have the correct equipment
- you have brought the homework required for submission that lesson
- you listen to instructions and explanations without interruption
- you complete all tasks set (and do not disrupt the learning of others)
- you participate actively in the lesson with a positive attitude (and you do not 'opt out')

Here is a list of the equipment you **must** bring to **every** lesson:

- Journal
- Black or blue pen
- Green pen
- Pencil, ruler, rubber
- Whiteboard & Whiteboard pen (the first one is provided by Ripley)
- Calculator – Casio fx-85GT PLUS
- Exercise books and textbooks required for your lessons each day
- Highlighter
- Reading book
- Glue stick

Subject-specific **essential** equipment:

- PE kit
- Black fine line pen/mechanical pencil
- Apron
- Compass and protractor

Arriving at lessons without the equipment listed above will result in lost learning time and will be sanctioned with 'clicks'.

RIPLEY BUSES

Make sure you know where the bus stop is and practise walking there so you know how long it takes. Many buses drop you at school and collect you from there but it is also a good idea to learn your way round Lancaster. Travel to the bus station or nearest stop and learn how to walk up to school.

Make sure you are at the bus stop a few minutes early. Stand with the other Ripley pupils and make sure the driver can see your blue blazer. **Put your hand out to stop the bus – it will not stop automatically.** At the end of school listen to instructions carefully so you get on the right bus. If you miss the bus TELL SOMEONE.

Make a plan so you know what to do if you miss the bus. Will you, for example...

Ring parents/emergency contact for a lift? Go to the main route bus stop to get another bus? Go to the bus station? Walk home?

Always make sure you have your bus pass/ticket with you. If your bus ticket is on your mobile phone, you will have to make sure it is charged and you have access to your data. If you have no pass with you, you will need to pay. **Carry some spare cash for emergencies.**
