

PUPIL TRAVEL SUBSIDIES FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2022-23

Travel subsidies are awarded to pupils who incur annual bus travel costs above £652.00. For passes costing over £800 annually, the subsidy will be £148.00 + 50% of the difference between £800 and the amount paid. (See examples below.)
