Year 7 Adventurous Geography residential

We are excited to inform you that the Geography Department is proposing to run a Year 7 residential trip to an outdoor education centre run by the FSC in Grange Over Sands in May 2023. The trip will fuse fieldwork with a variety of outdoor activities to give students the opportunity to explore real geographical contexts in an exciting and engaging way. The students will get first hand experiences of a range of physical landscapes where they will be encouraged to develop their team skills and individual motivation whilst involved in activities that promote a healthy lifestyle.

Dates of the trip:

Friday 5th May 2023 11:00am departure from Ripley Sunday 7th May 14:00pm return to Ripley

The approximate cost will be **£270**. This includes:

- Travel
- Full Board (Packed lunch will be required for the Friday, all meals provided after that)

We have included all activities in the initial cost. Activities to be included are:

- Canoeing
- River fieldwork
- Raft building
- Orienteering
- Ghyll Scrambling

The activities will be run by outdoor education professionals and all safety equipment will be supplied by the centre.

There is a limit of 40 spaces on this trip. At this stage, if you would like you child to be considered for a place on this trip, complete the attached expression of interest form. This should be placed in the blue box outside Learning Support in a sealed envelope clearly marked with your child's name and **Year 7 Adventurous Geography residential** by Monday 12th December.

If the trip is oversubscribed, pupils will be selected at random. All parents who have completed the expression of interest form will be notified by Tuesday 13^{th} December if a place has been allocated to their child. If so, a deposit of £70 will then be required by **Thursday 15th December.**
