Proposed Visit to Dukes Theatre to see French film, *Petite Maman*

We are delighted to inform you that the Languages Department are proposing to run a trip for year 9 pupils to The Dukes Theatre in Lancaster to see the French film *Petite Maman*. This will take place on **Monday 20th February at 6pm**. There are further details on the attached information sheet.

Petite Maman is a 2021 French fantasy drama film, written and directed by Céline Sciamma. The film received widespread critical acclaim. The film will be shown in French with English subtitles. This is an absolutely fantastic opportunity for our pupils to immerse themselves in French culture and pursue languages outside of the classroom whilst also developing their listening and reading comprehension skills.

The cost of this trip is £6 per pupil. This includes their cinema ticket as well as a drink and snack (French themed, bien sûr!) Pupils should be dropped off at the theatre at 5.45pm and collected at 7.30pm. They do not need to wear school uniform.

If you wish your son/daughter to take part in this visit, please complete the attached application form and the parental consent form (Form 3A) and pay by Wednesday 1st February. The forms should be returned to the blue box outside Learning Support in an envelope clearly marked with your son's/daughter's name and French theatre trip on the outside. If you have any problems using the online payment system please contact the school finance office for assistance.

Please note that late receipt of payment and/or forms will jeopardise your son's/daughter's opportunity to take part in the visit.
