

## KEY STAGE 4 CURRICULUM 2024-25

In key stage 4, all pupils study the **AQA Religious Studies** full course GCSE (specification A – Christian and Muslim beliefs and practices as well as four separate thematic studies).

## YEAR 10

This year provides a solid foundation for pupils now studying their full course Religious Studies GCSE (AQA). We focus heavily at the start on Islam as a deeper understanding of Muslim beliefs and practices is essential to a true grasp of the ethical issues posed in all 4 of the units we cover for Paper 2.

**10.1A** – **Theme B** - **Religion and life** – **PAPER 2** (6 lessons focusing on areas not covered in KS3, namely sanctity of life, abortion and euthanasia) **CHRISTIANITY & ISLAM** 

10.1 - Islamic beliefs - PAPER 1 (21 lessons) ISLAM

10.2 - Islamic practices - PAPER 1 (19 lessons) ISLAM

10.3 - Theme E - Crime & punishment - PAPER 2 (16 lessons) CHRISTIANITY & ISLAM

**10.4 – Theme A - Relationships and families – PAPER 2** (12 lessons – unit to be completed at start of year 11) **CHRISTIANITY & ISLAM** 

Each unit ends with a GCSE-style assessment comprising a 1, 2, 4, 5 and 12-mark question in timed, exam-like conditions. The end of year 10 mock exam assessment for RS is a 1 hour 45-minute exam covering 2 units from **PAPER 1** (**Islamic beliefs & Islamic practices**) and 2 units from **PAPER 2** (**Religion and life & Crime & punishment**).



## Year 11

This year completes our pupils' GCSE studies, focusing on an in-depth exploration of Christian beliefs and practices before spending time revising for the summer exams.

11.1 - Christian beliefs - PAPER 1 (21 lessons) CHRISTIANITY

11.2 - Christian practices - PAPER 1 (20 lessons) CHRISTIANITY

**11.3 – Theme D – Religion, peace and conflict – PAPER 2** (6 lessons focusing on areas not covered in KS3, namely Holy War in Christianity and Islam and Muslim responses to conflict, forgiveness, violent protest and terrorism) **CHRISTIANITY & ISLAM** 

Each unit ends with a GCSE-style assessment comprising a 1, 2, 4, 5 and 12-mark question in timed, exam-like conditions. There is at least 1 set of formal mock exams during year 11 and, as with year 10, all pupils will sit a 1 hour 45-minute exam covering 2 units from PAPER 1 (Christian beliefs & Christian practices) and 2 units from PAPER 2 (Relationships and families & Religion, peace and conflict).

The final external exams for RS are 2 x 1 hour 45-minute exams. **PAPER 1** covers all 4 units studied (**Islamic beliefs & Islamic practices**, **Christian beliefs & Christian practices**). **PAPER 2** covers all 4 units studied (**Theme A - Relationships and families, Theme B - Religion and life, Theme D - Religion, peace and conflict, <b>Theme E - Crime & punishment**).
