

Day starts at 8.40am

Transition days: timetable

- Pupils should wear primary school uniform.
- All pupils will follow a normal timetable covering a range of subjects.
- Pens and pencils will be needed.
- Lunch will be served early, £3 will cover the cost of a meal deal which includes a main meal, cake and a drink. Correct change is essential.
- Pupils will also need trainers for a P.E. Lesson.



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
