In preparation for Y12 you **must** get the following two set texts and bring them to your first lesson. They must be clean copies, with no annotations. You must read them before the course starts.



- > Use a range of vocal and physical skills to meet your dramatic intentions.



Part Three: Devising Task

As part of the course, you will be devising your own original piece of Theatre. You will need to source *3 stimuli* that could be used as a starting point for the devised piece. These should be thought provoking stimuli from the following categories;

- > Photographs
- > Literature/Poem
- > Art
- > Newspaper Article
- Song Lyrics
- > A piece of music
